Notice is hereby given that, at the dates, times and locations set out below, the following Hearings will be held by the Examining Authority (on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport ("the Secretary of State")) for the examination of the application made by Tritax Symmetry (Hinckley) Limited of Unit B, Grange Park Court, Roman Way, Northampton ("the Applicant") for a Development Consent Order ("the DCO") under the Planning Act 2008 ("the Application").

The Application (Reference No. TR050007) was made to the Secretary of State c/o the Planning Inspectorate under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 on 17 March 2023 and was accepted for examination on 13 April 2023. The Examining Authority was appointed on 11 July 2023 to examine the Application and the examination commenced following the preliminary meeting which took place 12 September 2023. The Application has been given Planning Inspectorate reference number TR050007.

#### In summary the Application seeks consent for the following works:

- a. New rail infrastructure off the Leicester to Hinckley railway;
- b. An intermodal freight terminal (rail port) capable of accommodating up to 16 trains per day;
- c. Up to 850,000 square metres of buildings for logistics use (comprising 650,000 square metres at ground floor level and a further 200,000 square metres of mezzanine floorspace) a use within class B8 of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes Order) 1987 as amended (warehouse and storage);
- d. Lorry Park with welfare facilities and HGV fuelling facilities;
- e. An energy centre;
- f. Highway works including:
- i. Provision of south facing slips onto Junction 2 of the M69;
- ii. A new highway link between Junction 2 and B4668 / A47 Leicester;
- iii. Improvements to existing highway junctions in the vicinity of the site.

The site lies 5 km to the north-east of Hinckley town centre, north-west of the M69 junction 2. A map showing the location of the HNRFI can be viewed on the National Infrastructure Planning website at the following link:

The Development Consent Order would authorise the compulsory acquisition of interests in land and rights over land, and the powers to use land permanently for the construction and operation of the HNRFI. It would also authorise the application and disapplication of certain legislation.
