VILLAGE BUS RETURNS

On Monday Nov 16th the bus service returned to the village, once again providing a link to Leicester and Hinckley.

It will operate between Fosse Park and Hinckley with the exception of one early morning bus and one afternoon bus to and from Leicester. For those who pay for a ticket you should be able to pay straight through to Leicester and catch a connecting Arriva bus at Fosse park.

The Parish Council has worked hard to get these buses back. It would have been impossible without the support of the village. We would especially like to thank the 120 villagers who turned up to "meet" the representatives of the bus company and Leicestershire County Council.

This undoubtedly was a crucial meeting which changed people's minds and set us on the way of getting these vital links back, all be it in a reduced form. We will continue to try to improve the service and would welcome feedback from bus users.



The re-routed Arriva X55 bus runs between Fosse Park and Hinckley via Thurlaston and Stoney Stanton. Buses to Hinckley depart at 08:51, 10:51, 12:51, 14:51 and 16:51 from Mondays to Saturdays. Buses to Fosse Park depart at 07:41, 09:51, 11:51, 13:51 and 15:44 from Mondays to Fridays. Additionally, the 07:41 continues into Leicester. Buses to Fosse Park depart at 07:46, 09:51, 11:51, 13:51 and 15:44 on Saturdays. Additionally, the 07:46 continues into Leicester.

ELECTORAL REVIEW OF LEICESTERSHIRE: DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has published draft recommendations on the future electoral arrangements for Leicestershire County Council. Today is the start of an 8 week public consultation on the Commission's draft recommendations on new electoral division boundaries across Leicestershire. The consultation closes on 11th January 2016.
